## **The Fall in Genesis 3 brought:**

- Sin
- Sickness
- Separation from God

Redemption addresses all three. If Jesus only forgave sin but left sickness untouched, redemption would be partial. But redemption is complete.

## **Illustration: Full Coverage Insurance.**


Imagine rebuilding a house but only repairing one room. Redemption is not a one-room renovation. Redemption restores spirit, soul, and body.

There is a divine order in Scripture. Healing is not a side doctrine. It is a redemptive reality. This morning we will walk through the progressive revelation of healing in redemption.

You must renew your mind to this covenant reality.

# **Healing: Promised, Purchased, and Present**





**1. HEALING PROMISED.  
(Isaiah 53:3-5)**

## **Isaiah 53:3-5 NKJV**

**3 “He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows (pains) and acquainted with grief (sickness). And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.**

**4 Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses) and carried our sorrows (pains); Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.”**

Isaiah was looking forward prophetically to the Cross.

The Hebrew words translated *griefs* and *sorrows* literally mean **sicknesses and pains**.


This is not symbolic language. Isaiah is describing a substitution.

- He bore our sins.
- He bore our sicknesses.
- He carried our pains.

Healing was not an afterthought. It was woven into the redemptive plan.

**Prophetic** **Insight:**

When Jesus went to the Cross, He didn't just deal with your sin problem — He dealt with your sickness problem.



## **2. HEALING PROCLAIMED. (Luke 4:16-21)**

## **Luke 4:16-21 NKJV**

**16 "So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. 17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it**

**was written: 18 "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."**

**20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."**

***Luke 4*** is King Jesus announcing His Mission:

- . Freedom
- . Restoration
- . Healing

If healing was in His opening statement, it is still His Kingdom agenda today. Healing was central to His anointing.

## **Matthew 9:35 NKJV**

**“Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the Kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.”**

**3. HEALING DEMONSTRATED.  
(Matthew 8:16-17)**


## **Matthew 8:16-17 NKJV**

**16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."**

The Holy Spirit interprets ***Isaiah 53*** as physical healing.

If someone argues Isaiah was only spiritual, Matthew clarifies it. The Designer explains His own design.

There is no better Bible commentary than the Holy Spirit!



# **4. HEALING PURCHASED.**

## **(1 Peter 2:24)**

## **1 Peter 2:24 NKJV**

**“Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.”**


## **Illustration: The Receipt**

When you leave a store, the receipt proves purchase.

The stripes of Jesus are Heaven's receipt for healing!

Symptoms may argue. Medical reports may speak.

But the receipt speaks louder!



**5. HEALING CONTINUES.  
(Hebrews 13:8)**

**Hebrews 13:8 NKJV**

**“Jesus Christ is the same  
yesterday, today, and forever.”**

## **Illustration: The Unchanging Sun**

Clouds may block your view, but the sun has not stopped shining.

## **Deuteronomy 29:29 NKJV**

**“The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.”**

This answers the unspoken objection: **“But was that only for then?”**

**Hebrews 13:8 establishes:**

- If He healed yesterday,
- If healing was part of redemption,
- If the Cross secured it,
- Then His unchanging nature guarantees its availability today.

# **The Complete Redemptive Flow:**

**Isaiah — Healing Promised**

**Luke — Healing Proclaimed**

**Matthew — Healing Demonstrated**

**Peter — Healing Purchased**

**Hebrews — Healing Continues**

**Isaiah promised it.**

**Jesus announced it.**

**Jesus demonstrated it.**

**The Cross secured it.**

**And Jesus still does it.**

Salvation and healing operate on the same principle. You believe and receive.

### **Illustration: Opening the Door**

If a gift is delivered, but you never open the door, you do not enjoy what is legally yours.

Faith opens the door to what grace has provided. Healing is not manufactured by faith. Healing is received by faith.

You do not feel saved into salvation. You believe into salvation.

**Likewise:**

You do not feel healed into healing. You believe into healing.

Faith does not deny symptoms. Faith does not deny reality.

Faith declares a higher truth — the finished work of Christ. Faith declares a higher covenant reality.

**Healing is redemption's present provision.**

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
