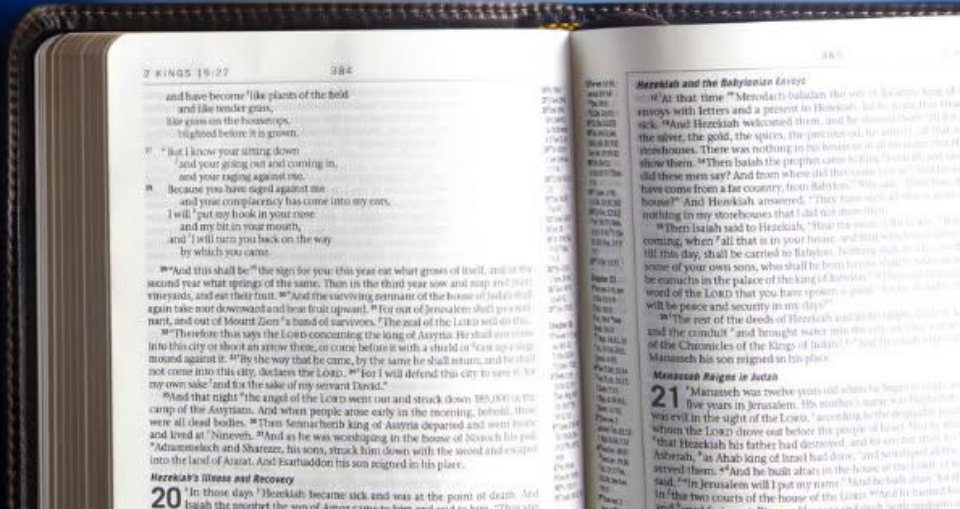


THE *Last* TRUMP

Hezekiah's Illness and Recovery

Manasseh Reigns in Judah

The phrase “the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy” means that all prophecy, past, present, and future, reveals the heart of Jesus Christ.

- **The 2 Trumpets - I call them the First and Last Trump by God.**

The Place of Trumpeting - The SW corner of the Temple. A replica of the Trumpeting Stone. (The original is in the Israel Museum.) Hebrew inscription on the stone - "To the place of trumpeting to herald the Sabbath." Announced worship times & celebrations, signaled the Sabbath, sounded alarms, and they infuriated the Romans!


**The Arch of Titus in Rome. (50' high)
When the Temple was destroyed in
A.D. 70, the Romans took the Menorah
(symbol of God's Presence), Table of
Showbread (symbol of Covenant &
Fellowship) and the 2 Trumpets
(symbol of God's Voice). They were
paraded with pride by the Romans
signaling that the Jewish God was
dead.**



Silver trumpets have been replicated and crafted by the Jerusalem Temple Institute for Temple Worship.





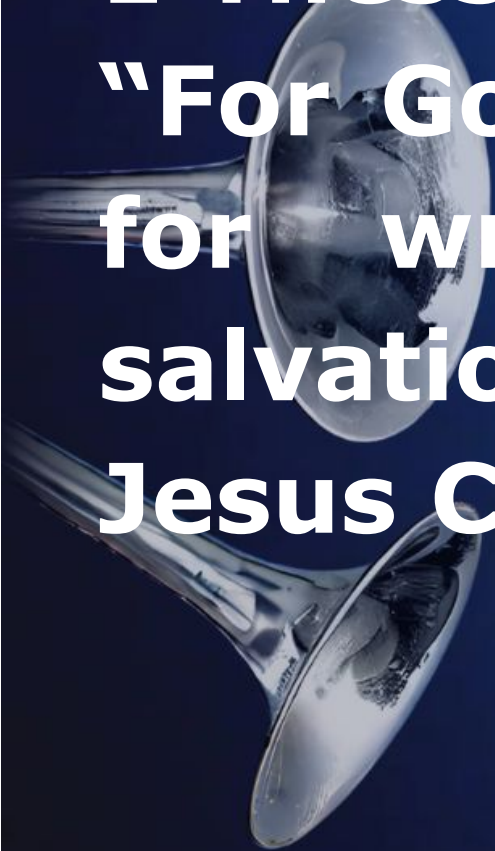

Greek scholars say “falling away comes first” doesn’t mean falling away from the faith, but it means “the catching away of the church.”

When we go up, he (the anti-christ) shows up.

Revelation 4:1 ESV

After this I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven! And the first voice, which I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this."

Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever.”

This is not the last trump of God. This is the 7th trumpet of judgment blown by an angel. It's a trumpet of wrath. Jesus mentions this trumpet in **Matthew 24:29-31. This trump announces the change in administration.**

The Last Trump is a change of location!

Exodus 19:13, 19 ESV

“...When the trumpet sounds a long blast, they shall come up to the mountain (Sinai). 19 And as the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him in thunder.”





- **The First Trump - Trump of Law.**

- **The Last Trump - Trump of Grace announcing that The Church Age, the age of grace is over.**

***The First Trump of God laid
down the Law. The Last
Trump of God lifts us up!**



The Doctrine of Imminency:

The belief that the Lord Jesus Christ could return at any moment, without warning.
